



Malachi—Faithful Love

Karen Nettleton was your average grandmother, boasting five grandchildren and a simple life living in Sydney, Australia. However, Karen's life was forever changed in 2014 when her daughter, Tara, said that the family was going on a holiday to Malaysia. But the destination was not Malaysia. Rather, it was to Syria, where Tara's husband, Khaled Sharrouf, joined ISIS, and the family gained international notoriety in a heartbeat. Karen's quest to rescue her now orphaned refugee grandchildren from among 70,000 inhabitants of the Al-Howl camp in Syria was a feature of a recent ABC doco. Her faithful commitment to these powerless kids with a controversial surname is an astonishing example of covenant love that will go to great lengths to see relationships restored.



In Malachi chapter 2, the ire of the prophet against God's people was due to faith-less-ness in regard to relationships in households, and raises the always urgent cry for fidelity and harmony, especially among those who know love of that kind from God.
