Indigenous Garden Launch Postponed

The October 26 event has been postponed. Plans of the existing garden were provided to the Wurundjeri Corporation to gain their guidance for the garden redesign, but the Wurundjeri have been offered a plot in Healesville to establish their bush food production project. We shall now go ahead and develop a new garden design and consult the Wurundjeri about the plan and plant selection. From our discussions with Charley Woolmore, Special Projects Manager at the Wurundjeri Corporation, we have been made aware of facets of design that mean a lot to the Wurundjeri and other indigenous people which we could try to include.
